Satori School Update ~ February 18, 2022

Dear Satori Students, Families, and Staff,

I have been spending the last few days watching our staff and students and am beyond impressed how well everyone is doing with our mitigation plan. While watching COVID cases in Tucson go down, I decided to connect with PCHD, the CDC, and an epidemiologist who knows Satori well and see what they thought about lifting our mandatory outside mask mandate. With all the information I gave them, they agreed that this would be fine as long as the students and staff still wear masks inside (and outside if they cannot maintain 6ft for more than 15 minutes).

As of Monday, February 21, 2022, masks will be optional when outside, but still required when in the buildings. If we find that cases are increasing again in Tucson or we have any close contacts, we will have to revise our ever-changing plan again.

Students who have had a close contact but have been vaccinated would still be required to wear a mask at all times for 5-10 days per close contact regulations.

Thank you for your continued support through these times. I am thankful every day to be part of a community like Satori.
