HOW TO SIGN UP

Registration will be online this year. The link with a password for access will be emailed to families Saturday, August 17th. Registration for after school activities will begin at 12PM Saturday and will continue online until 5:30PM, Friday August 23. Registration is first come first serve, and class sizes are limited.

After-school Activities and Extended Care Charges:

- If your child is not enrolled in Full-time Extended Care, you will be billed for Extended Care charges ***in addition to the activity fee:***
 - Preschool – 1st Grade: \$10.00/hour
 - 2nd Grade – 8th Grade. \$10.00/hour with a \$100.00

required deposit.

- These Extended Care charges accrue until you pick up your child each day.
- There is no credit given for activities fees when your child is absent. You will not be billed for the Extended Care time.
- All activities are billed monthly. *Rates are based on the number of weeks per month and will vary according to the number of classes per month.*
- Requests for changes like dropping or adding an activity must be made prior to the beginning of a new month (or new activity session) by filling out a change of status sheet. These are available in the office.
- All changes take effect at the beginning of the following month with no changes mid-month/mid-session.

Extended Care After-school Activities, 2024 - 2025:

CHESS CLUB (Private & Charter School)

Participants will have fun in chess matches and sharpen their thinking skills while learning and playing this fascinating, classic game. Beginners will learn about chess pieces and their moves, board layout, and game play; intermediate players will expand their understanding of strategies. This may include competing in tournaments against other schools. Fee is charged every 8 weeks (about 2 months), not by calendar months. Fridays per month may vary, but the cost does not.

GUITAR Lessons (Private & Charter)

Noah has been with the Satori family for several years teaching guitar. During Guitar lessons, students will learn the fundamentals of good technique, be introduced to scales, chords, rhythms, and ear training, and learn music pieces based on their individual interests.

A game often continues over a series of meetings to complete a single adventure, and longer into a series of related gaming adventures, called a "campaign". The students will learn how the system works, make a playable character in that system, and then have an adventure in that world. RPG is a great way for students to explore a variety of social and other useful cognitive skills, such as logic, basic mathematics and imagination while having fun!
